Calves are born with virtually no immune function and have little or no natural ability to defend themselves against pathogen exposure. This leaves them vulnerable to disease. Calf feeding during the first days of life must provide both disease protection as well as the right nutrition for optimal development.

Proactive management of calf nutrition not only reduces mortality, especially in their first week of life, but can also result in reduced feed costs due to quicker weaning and average first calving dates reduced by as much as two months.

As well as the nutritional needs of calves, attention needs to be paid to their physical environment. Calves should be reared in clean and dry facilities with good access to food and clean water. It is important that moisture in these areas is kept to a minimum as that can harbour bacteria and pathogens. Bedding materials are available that keep the area free from moisture and ammonia smells.

Bedding Spreader

Quickly and efficiently maximise your barn and calf pens comfort levels and resting area hygiene with the spreader that evenly distributes DryMaxx™ bedding material to approximately 120 freestalls using a 100 gram/m² application and up to 240 freestalls using a 50 gram/m² application. The Bedding Spreader runs off a cordless drill (not supplied).

Colostrum is the most important ingredient in calf rearing. A calf is born without any protection against the pathogens in the environment. To help make sure you have an adequate supply of colostrum, Feedtech[™] Colostrum Preserver acidifies colostrum allowing it to be stored for up to 6 months.

Colostrum Preserver can be used to acidify and stabilise milk to a pH 4.5 if used at 3%, 600ml per 20L milk, and held for 8 hrs before feeding to calves. Acidifying milk to a pH of 4.5 can assist with preventing the biological risks within milk.

Santech-TC contains a powerful twin chain QAC sanitiser that has excellent germicidal activity when used as a surface sanitiser. It is ideal for use around and in calf pens prior to them being used for prevention of viral outbreaks. It can also be used in higher concentrations when there is an incidence of high bacterial or viral contamination.

DeLaval Calf Feeder CF150X is the economical answer to an automated calf rearing system. Available in single (25 calves), double milk (50 calves) or Combi units (25 calves milk and feed) the CF150 is durable, effective and efficient. It will simultaneously handle the feeding of 100-200 calves (depending on station type). Up to four stations can be controlled by one processor.

The DeLaval PC Link system links processor(s) to your central computer. Up to 10 processors can be linked to one PC Link system. The PC Link can be used to centrally programme feed plans to each station.

Investing in an automated calf feeding system pays for itself quickly. Milk and concentrate rations are set up for individual calves, which means feed programmes can be individually tailored if required. Up to 99 feed plans can be entered. The user friendly software, simple interface and exception reports simplify your daily routine and put you in control of your calf rearing operation.

Flexibility and reliability

DeLaval calf feeders offer a whole range of possibilities to help you raise your calves as you desire. With a DeLaval calf feeder, you can:

- Save time the system does the work for you, providing milk 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
- Create your own feeding schedule: decide the optimum milk ration for each calf.
- Feed small portions regularly throughout the day.
- Provide perfectly dissolved and blended milk replacer.
- Provide milk that is always the temperature you decide (milk tank includes agitator on timer).
- Feed your calves regularly around the clock, helping prevent cross-suckling.
- Wean your calves gently by gradually reducing their milk rations and constantly developing the rumen.
- Available in milk/concentrate station and single milk station Configurations:
 - → 100 calves milk/grain
 - → 200 calves milk/milk

DeLaval CF1000S has a direct connection from feeder to PC/router via an Ethernet cable and the management programme has flexible feeding plans for fresh milk, CMR and concentrate. An auto calibration system is included which automatically calibrates the milk powder volumes programmed in the system.

DeLaval calf feeder CF1000S freshly prepared

When a calf enters a milk station the CF1000S prepares precise instant portions of fresh milk at the right temperature, provided the calf is allowed to drink.

The milk station identifies each calf by its electronic transponder, knows the calf's feeding plan, when it is allowed to drink, and how much.

CF1000S can handle four teat units and up to 120 calves. The combi version can mix fresh milk, powder and water in any combination.
